#### Statistics:

Check-ins were about the same as last month. Traffic continued to be very low. Let's try to do as Rodney asked last month and originate some simple greeting messages to family and friends out-of-state.

Rodney, W5DY, with 39 (63%) claimed top QNI spot, Tom, NK5Z, claimed 2<sup>nd</sup> with 31 (50%). Floyd, N5EL, captured 3<sup>rd</sup> with 25 (40%), all on the early session. Thanks to all who checked in for your support. The QNI count is actually improved over the previous month since I missed quite a number of days in July.

Larry, KC0M, joined us from his Branson, MO, home with traffic, and we are happy to have Adam, N0SSS, join us from Oklaunion. Adam has been on TSN and is doing well with his traffic originations and the responses coming back to him. His code speed is improving as a result. Net controls are again reminded to slow down to the speed at which a station checks in to acknowledge him or to give direction. We need to help out the new traffic handlers as much as we can and not "scare them away" by sending too fast.

The complete list of stations and traffic / liaison totals are shown in the following table. Traffic averaged 1.8 per net session (2.2 last month). Net time averaged 11.8 minutes per session (compared to 12.3 last month). Check-ins averaged 4.4 per session (4.5 last month).

When sending traffic, please try to include a valid phone number. If you are sending to friends and family, double check that number. Many times the phone number is for a cell phone or it is an unlisted number. Many traffic handlers try to look up the phone numbers for the addressee to verify having a correct number before trying to deliver traffic. If they can't verify the number they make the call and hope that no one has scrambled the number along the way. This is practice for us for a time when delivery is critical. Also, include a correct and current address.

This month TSN had some fun thanks to N0SSS. Adam had an incoming message addressed to him with no phone number. The sender simply put "C/O Texas Slow Net". Steve, K6JT, picked up the traffic and knew immediately to pass it along to me. We delivered the traffic and had some fun with it.
